Article 17. Orientation and Continuing Education - Adding a reference to Article 20, Administrative Policies

Article 18. Processing Fees - Adding an exception for cell tower fees; Specifying that the current year's Midwest Region March CPI-U will be used to adjust fees; Removing the outdated table of fees. The current fee schedule will be maintained on the Commission's website; Fixing a typo

Administrative Policy 9: Continuing Education Records - Deleting a duplicate paragraph; Allowing the electronic submittal of the continuing education form; Fixing a typo

Administrative Policy 10: Due Process; Regular and Special Meeting Agenda; Rules of Order - Adding language to allow the chairperson call a special meeting and divide agenda items up when there are a large number of submittals; Clarifying that the order of business applies to regular and special meetings. Also allows the acting chairperson to determine the placement of issues on the agenda in the event a

regular and special meeting are necessary; Updating some formatting issues, references to NKAPC, and typos; Updating the public hearing procedures to reflect the current procedures
