

The City of Erlanger experienced early development with the creation of a land syndicate and financial help from Baron Frederic Emile d'Erlanger. The land syndicate enabled a railroad stop in the City, which led to rapid growth and its incorporation in 1897. Another growth spurt happened in the 1960s with the construction of I-75.




