


The land that is now known as Ludlow was given to a General in recognition of service during the Revolutionary War. However, the General traded the land to Thomas Carneal, who constructed Elmwood Hall on the riverfront in 1818. Eventually, Ludlow would be named after its final owner, Israel Ludlow, and be incorporated in 1864.


